<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; background-color: red; color: white; margin: 0;"><b>IN CASE OF EMERGENCY</b></p> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: small;">Cornell University Fire Safety Plan (April 2008 - final draft)</p> <div style="text-align: right; margin-bottom: 10px;"> </div> <p><b>Fire Emergency</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. REPORT</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Alert others in the immediate area and evacuate the room.</li> <li>Activate fire alarm pull boxes to sound the alarm.</li> <li>The fire department is automatically notified.</li> <li><b>CALL 911</b> from a safe location.</li> <li>Report the location and size of the fire.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>2. CONFINE THE FIRE BY CLOSING THE DOOR TO THE ROOM.</b></li> <li><b>3. EXIT VIA THE NEAREST SAFE ESCAPE ROUTE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Feel the upper part of the door - do not open if it is hot.</li> <li>Open door slowly if it is cool, be ready to close it if smoke or heat is present.</li> <li>Walk, do not run to exits. Use stairways to exit, do not use elevators.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>4. MOVE TO YOUR EMERGENCY MEETING SITE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recount any missing or trapped people to the emergency responders.</li> <li>Move away from the building.</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p><b>Medical Emergency</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. PROTECT VICTIMS FROM FURTHER INJURY</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Personne are permitted to treat to the victim.</li> <li>Do not move the victim unnecessarily.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>2. CALL 911 TO OBTAIN EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Report the location of the persons and the nature and extent of injuries.</li> <li>Call from a safe location.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>3. PROVIDE FIRST AID IF YOU HAVE APPROPRIATE TRAINING</b></li> </ol> <p><b>Police Emergency</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. PROTECT YOURSELF FROM HARM</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attempt to remove yourself from any danger.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>2. CALL 911 TO OBTAIN POLICE ASSISTANCE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If possible, call from a safe location.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>3. PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO THE POLICE:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Location of crime</li> <li>Nature of crime &amp; suspects</li> <li>Description of suspects</li> <li>Direction of travel of suspects</li> <li>Any injuries</li> <li>Description of vehicles involved</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>4. DO NOT PURSUE OR ATTEMPT TO DETAIN SUSPECTS</b></li> </ol> <p><b>Other Emergencies</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1.
