

## Steps for Chemical “Hazardous Waste” Removal

1. Complete a green Hazardous Waste tag and attach to container. This is required for each individual item to be removed. (Labels can be requested by calling 255-8200.)

PRESS HARD WITH BALL-POINT PEN AND PEEL AT SLIT!  
DETACH TOP COPY AND CARBON AT PERFORATION! ATTACH  
BOTTOM COPY TO CONTAINER. SEND TOP COPY TO:

2. Place all Hazardous Waste containers into a UN rated DOT box.
  - a. DOT boxes can be found at: Baker Institute B18, Baker Lab 358, Bard Hall B60, Biotech G43, Bradfield Hall G03, Clark Hall E-21, MVR Hall loading dock, Plant Science loading dock, Vet College Complex - VMC C1-053. Olin and Comstock Hall – see Building Coordinator.
  - b. Chemical shipping boxes are UN rated and can be re-used with proper inserts.



3. Leave the top copy of the Hazardous Waste tag in the box with the items to be removed.
4. Request a pick-up online at [www.ehs.cornell.edu](http://www.ehs.cornell.edu). Click *Waste Pick Ups* button on left.
5. All chemical hazardous waste removal requests received before 7 am Friday will be removed that day. (Any requests received before 7 am Wed. may be removed that day if time permits.)
6. Leave chemical hazardous waste boxes in an obvious location in the same room for removal.
